What is an Endowment?

An endowment is money that is given or set aside as a permanent fund to meet special, designated or emergency needs not met through current income. An endowment is meant to last in perpetuity and only the income or a specific percentage of the market value should be expended each year. The endowment is a lasting legacy by members or friends of the church to continue their giving after they're gone for the ministry of the church.

Planned gifts, such as bequests, life income arrangements and gifts of real property or other appreciated assets, can grow into substantial endowment funds that nourish and sustain local church ministries well into the future.
